

Spirit Come

The chorus of this song offers a simple and beautiful prayer of invocation. It can stand alone as a response between spoken stanzas of a prayer or sung as a meditative chant. The chorus can also be sung in echo-style for added beauty. Though the eighth-notes create the illusion of a jazzy rhythm, the song is best suited for an easy-going lilt. Sing the verses with an almost waltz-like rhythm, emphasizing the words such as "bring-good-news," of the longer-held notes.
